YEARS 1-6 / AGES 5-11

Our Primary Curriculum has been designed to nurture your child to become an informed, globally competent, and future-ready learner.

We have combined the enquiry-based and creative approach of the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) with the balance and rigour of English and Maths from the English National Curriculum to create a stimulating and well-rounded Primary learning programme. Your child's wellbeing always comes first, and we place a strong emphasis on Personal, Social, Health, and Emotional education (PSHE).

Our cohesive, topic-led approach integrates History, Geography, Science, Arts, ICT, Technology, and International Mindedness and Society around a central theme. From Year 3 these subjects may be taken in either English or French.

Specialised teachers provide PE (including swimming and skiing), Music, Drama, French (as both a first and foreign language), and the option of learning German.

Our focus on knowledge, skills, and understanding, supported by teacher- and student-led assessments, ensures academic rigour and progression in readiness for the next stage in their academic journey at LCIS.

LOWER SECONDARY CURRICULUM

YEARS 7-9 / AGES 11-14

The Lower Secondary Curriculum supports a smooth transition from Primary education, gradually preparing students to study towards their external exams - the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSEs) - in Year 10 and 11.

Our students build on their learning to ensure they acquire a solid foundation of knowledge, skills, and understanding to prepare them for the challenging and rigorous IGCSE and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). Benefiting from a holistic approach supporting academic, emotional, and social development we help our students live their values, achieve their goals, and shine.



Opportunities to apply learning in new contexts give it meaning and lead to a deeper understanding. We run cross-curricular activities and project days and give our students the chance to take part in fun and competitive external academic events. Progress for each student is closely monitored by our passionate and diligent teachers, through ongoing formative and summative appraisal.

INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION

YEARS 10-11 / AGES 14-16

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is one of the most academically challenging international qualifications for 14- to 16-year-olds. It is recognised by leading universities and employers worldwide.

This highly respected, exam-based curriculum is assessed by Cambridge International Education, and Pearson Edexcel, through a combination of coursework, assignments, oral and written examinations.

In addition to core subjects such as English, Mathematics, Science, and French (either as a first or foreign language), students can tailor their learning towards future goals choosing from electives including Academic PE, Art, Business Studies, Design Technology, Drama, Music, Computer Science, German, Spanish, History, Geography, and English as an Additional Language. Altogether they study for 8 to 10 separate subjects.

We place a strong emphasis on Personal, Social, Health, and Economic education (PSHE), outdoor activities, and service and leadership experiences that cultivate essential skills such as communication, collaboration, adaptability, and respect.

The content-rich IGCSE curriculum requires students to learn about specific topics in detail. It is academically demanding, with a broad range of topics within core subjects like Science, Maths, and English. Working towards an examination in each IGCSE subject prepares our students well for the rigorous academic requirements of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Years 12 and 13.



INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

YEARS 12-13 / AGES 16-18

As an International School, LCIS has chosen the internationally recognised and highly respected International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) to give our graduates the international and Swiss choices they deserve for their further education. The adaptability of the IBDP means it provides an academically rigorous route to the best universities worldwide for all sorts of learner profiles.

Every year LCIS students are accepted to the best Swiss and international institutions. There, prepared and equipped with skills to be curious and thoughtful, to question and research, and to be excellent communicators, LCIS's graduates thrive.

The IBDP gives our students a unique, challenging, and diverse education. The programme focuses on 10 characteristics that reach beyond academic success, and make up the IBDP learner profile.

We aim to develop young people who are:

 Knowledgeable
 Thinkers
 Communicators
 Principled
- Open-minded Caring Risk-takers Balanced Reflective

Fundamental, transferable skills set our young people up with the ability to adapt in a fast-changing world.

Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), and the Extended Essay (EE) make up the IBDP core. Designed to encourage self-directed learning, these subjects enable students to reflect on the nature of knowledge, research independently, and engage with the wider community.



As well as the core components, students select one subject from each of: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics, and one additional subject from either Arts, Sciences, Humanities, or Languages. The wide range of subjects on offer at LCIS allows students to tailor their studies to their interests and aspirations. This is backed up with a rich extra-curricular offering, including: field trips for Biology and Geography, participation in the Model United Nations, our CAS (Creativity, Activity, Service) Residential Trip, the opportunity to apply for the Student Body Leadership Team, supporting the learning of younger students, engaging in community-wide activities, and volunteering to help with and support school productions.

Our small class sizes and highly personalised academic and pastoral support, alongside university counselling, ensure excellent future opportunities for all our graduates.

BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

Extra-curricular expeditions, events, explorations, and escapes for everyone!

We want our students to become responsible global citizens. Our opportunities in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Maths), Performing Arts, Sports and Wellbeing, Academics, Languages, the Model United Nations (MUN) and the International Award, along with field trips and annual residential camps, give our students plenty of chances for learning beyond the classroom.

Two years ago, a group of our students took a life-changing 11-day Community Action Service trip to Thailand where LCIS students immersed themselves in the local culture, planted mangroves, taught English in a remote school, visited care homes, and more. The following year, another group of students continued to build on this project in Thailand to continue to develop this meaningful partnership with these communities. Last year, students returned to NAE's expedition base in Arusha, Tanzania, embarking on an incredible journey to climb Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest point in Africa. The experience truly pushed their limits, fostering resilience, teamwork, and personal growth — and gave them the opportunity to create memories they'll cherish forever.

LCIS students may also participate in the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Scheme. As part of the programme students learn the importance of self-discipline, enterprise, and effort. Each award level includes a 2, 3, or 4-day expedition either in the Swiss Alps or Jura Mountains. Participation in the scheme is a personal challenge, not a competition; the award encourages young people to design their own programme of activities, set their own goals, and challenge themselves to achieve those goals. It can play a critical role in your child's development outside the classroom. Students' achievement in the programme is recognised worldwide.
